About the Course	<p>Law is an exciting subject, taught in a dynamic way involving the full range of learning activities. You do not need to have studied the subject before but you do need to have a keen interest in the subject. The study of Law requires you to process a large volume of information about cases, acts, practices and procedures. It also requires lateral thinking and enhances your problem solving skills.</p> <p>The course provides an introduction to the legal systems in England and Wales.</p> <p>In your first year you will study: Law Making and the Legal System and The Concept of Liability.</p> <p>In your second year you will study: Criminal Law (Offences Against the Person) and Criminal Law (Offences Against Property) and Concepts of Law.</p>
Progression Routes	<p>The study of Law is not exclusive to those considering careers such as solicitors or barristers. Obviously, many of our past students have gone on to pursue careers as lawyers and some have progressed into the police force. Law is recognised as a challenging and demanding subject which enhances problem solving skills and these skills are seen as transferable to a variety of subjects at University on most courses.</p>
Method of Assessment	<p>This course is assessed by two examinations in the first year and two examinations in the second year.</p>
