About the Course	<p>This practical course is designed as an introduction to the Performing Arts and is suitable for those students who wish to extend their knowledge of the performance industry. All students should be prepared to be involved in practical performance for this course. You will study a range of units including:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Production Process – in this unit you will put into practice the process of creating a performance from initial idea to the first night. 2. The Performing Arts Business – here you will learn about the various roles and job opportunities in the performing arts industry. 3. Understanding Dance – through practical devising and looking at the work of others, you will learn about styles of dance and dance techniques. 4. Devising Plays – in this unit you will be involved in the creation and presentation of a play.
Progression Routes	Successful students will be able to progress to Level 3 Performing Arts related courses. Many students will then progress to university to study the performing arts further or pursue a career in the creative / performance industry.
Method of Assessment	Although the majority of the course is assessed through practical performance, there are also a range of written assignments that need to be completed.
