About the Course	BTEC Subsidiary Diploma in Performing Arts (Acting) is a two-year practical course equivalent to one A level. On this course you will develop a broad range of acting skills and techniques that explore both classical and contemporary theatre. In the first year of study you will complete units such as Performing to an Audience and Principles of Acting. Specialist options will also be chosen that may include Devising Plays, Musical Theatre Performance, Developing Voice for the Actor, Acting Auditions, Applying Acting Skills, Drama Improvisation, Developing Movement Skills, Movement in Performance, Film and TV Acting, and Storytelling as Performance.
Progression Routes	BTEC Subsidiary Diploma is valued by employers and universities alike. The course is good preparation for further study of acting and other related areas of the performing arts at drama school or university
Method of Assessment	The Subsidiary Diploma in Acting is assessed through a range of practical and written assignments.
