

Course Title	BTEC Level 3 Subsidiary Diploma in Performing Arts (Dance)
Level	Level 3: BTEC
About the Course	<p>This two year, A-Level equivalent modular course is taught through a combination of practical and written assignments. You will study a range of modules including two core topics, Dance Performance and Performing to an Audience, where you will devise your own choreographic material for an evening performance. The course is aimed at those students who are enthusiastic about practical dance and wish to develop their technical and creative skills, creating choreography in groups and individually. The course provides you with the opportunity to study a range of different dance styles including physical theatre, contemporary dance and international style dances. Throughout the course you will participate in a range of performances to help you broaden your understanding of the world of dance and prepare you for full time training. You must have a strong technical training in dance or have studied dance at GCSE level. An audition may be required for this course.</p>
Progression Routes	Students who successfully complete this course may progress to further education, specialising in dance choreography and performance.
Method of Assessment	The BTEC Subsidiary Diploma in Performing Arts (Dance) is assessed through a range of practical performances, workshops, and written/presentation assignments.
