

Course Title	A Level English Literature

About the Course	<p>You will study a range of literary texts including poetry, prose and drama, with the addition of some independent wider reading. You will analyse how texts relate to one another and certain literary traditions / movements, plus how texts are interpreted by different readers, including over time.</p> <p>As part of the coursework assessment at AS Level, you will have the opportunity to produce some original writing, inspired by your own independent wider reading.</p> <p>To get the most out of your course you should be an enthusiastic reader and be prepared for extensive reading, including reading around the subject to inform your interpretation of texts.</p> <p>You should be willing to justify your ideas during class discussions and in written essays, and enjoy working both independently and in a group.</p>
Progression Routes	<p>English Literature is a widely recognised academic subject that can be combined with Arts, Science or Mathematics for entry into Higher Education. It prepares you for careers which require good communication skills such as Teaching, Law, Civil and Social Services, Journalism and Media, Libraries and most management areas.</p>
Method of Assessment	<p>Coursework is worth 40% of your overall grade at both AS and A2 Level.</p> <p>One 2.5 hour examination worth 60% of overall grade at both AS and A2 Level.</p>
