

Course Title	BTEC Level 2 Diploma in Health and Social Care

About the Course	<p>This course consists of 8 units which include Human Lifespan Development, Vocational Experience in a Health or Social Care Setting and Anatomy and Physiology for Health and Social Care.</p> <p>As part of this course students undertake 60 hours of work placement experience. This helps to support the understanding of the links between theory and practice within the vocational context. .</p> <p>The BTEC Level 2 Diploma in Health and Social Care relates to the National Occupational Standards in Health and Social Care and provides underpinning knowledge for these standards. The course enables learners to gain a clear insight into the Health and Social Care sector and therefore learners who successfully complete this qualification should be able to progress to employment in the sector in a supervised role.</p>
Progression Routes	<p>Many of our learners progress on to Level 3 courses in Health and Social Care within college or take up employment within the care sector. This may be as a Care Assistant within the private sector, Nursery Assistant or Health Care Assistant.</p>
Method of Assessment	<p>The course is assessed through observational visits in the work place setting, and course work which is graded at Pass, Merit or Distinction. There are no examinations on this course.</p>
