About the Course	<p>18 different units are covered during this 2 year course. Core units include The Principles of Anatomy &amp; Physiology in Sport where aspects of the body and its systems are studied; and Assessing Risk in Sport which looks into the various Health &amp; Safety implications for providing sporting experiences to the general public. Other units cover Leadership, where sessions are planned, delivered and evaluated by students as part of their portfolio. Students are expected to complete a 2 week voluntary work placement as part of their studies.</p> <p>Throughout the year pupils complete a full portfolio which contains evidence on the completion of tasks. Assignments are set approximately every six weeks for each unit of study. Students must be well organised and disciplined as there are occasions when there is more than one deadline to be met in the same week.</p>
Progression Routes	Successful completion of this course prepares students for a career in the sport, health, leisure and fitness industries or in teaching.
Method of Assessment	18 units of study 100% Portfolio assessment.
