About the Course	<p>During the course you will study Global Challenges and Geographical Investigations. Within these two units, there are compulsory human and physical geography topics, ranging from crowded coasts, re-branded rural and urban environments (Geographical Investigations) and globalisation/population dynamics, to 'global hazards'.</p> <p>In the second year you will study units on the Contested Planet and Geographical Research. These final two units are much more synoptic in nature and will bring together all physical and human aspects of Geography, for instance the conflict and struggles associated with energy and water resources combined with the issue of the widening development gap.</p>
Progression Routes	A Geographical qualification can lead onto study in Higher Education (Geography degree for example) and careers in the public and private sectors, including, environmental monitoring, hydrology & river management (working with the Environment Agency), town & country planning, consultancy and marketing.
Method of Assessment	100% written examinations. Two at AS in the AS year and two in the A2 year.
