About the Course	<p>During the AS course you will first study the Experience of Warfare in Britain. We will examine the key events of the Crimean, Boer and First World War, including the role of Florence Nightingale and the debate over 'Lions v Donkeys'. In the second part of the course we will look at dictators of the twentieth century, with the triumph of Mussolini and Fascist Italy alongside the Rise and Fall of Nazi Germany.</p> <p>In the A2 course, you will complete a coursework project on the development of anti-Semitism in Germany, beginning in the Napoleonic period, and culminating with the Holocaust. The final module is an examination of the nature of Superpower relations and the emergence of the Cold War in Europe and Asia following the end of World War Two; culminating ultimately with the downfall of the 'Evil Empire'.</p>
Progression Routes	Universities like to recruit history students because of the analytical skills that they have developed. Many employers like to recruit history graduates onto their management schemes. You could also focus on careers in law, accountancy, business management, teaching, publishing and banking.
Method of Assessment	Three modules are based on written examinations with a combination of essay and source based questions. The final module is a coursework unit.
